I ran from the internal drive because macupdate said you updated the program so i wanted to run the updater on my master image.

so here's what's interesting: first, macupdate was publishing old news as you know. second, your updater is broken. Details....little snitch shows me that your application is not communicating. in your app i get a spinning beachball which eventually times out with a message like 'the server is too busy' or some such rot.

all that is livable. but the third issue: your software asked me for its serial number twice today.1) the first time when i ran it this morning. 2) and the second time after I restarted the machine. of course i fixed this autostartup business but something must be misbehaving if it keeps asking me for a S/N.

ok i am guessing this might be my fault: I can't blame you for my system behavior. Let's say there's some sort of permissions issue so the app couldn't write my S/N.

I will let you know if this becomes a re-occurring annoyance.
